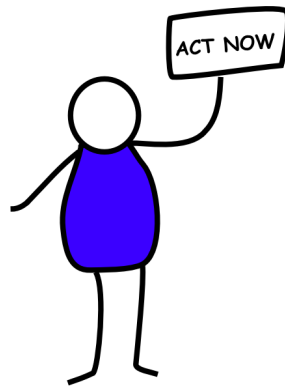


Climate Change
